The Broome Public Library is equipped to meet the needs of members of the community who are in need of special library facilities and services.

The library has access ramps, desks and bathroom facilities to meet disability access requirements.

The Library offers many titles in audio formats, larger print, books written in languages other than English and an extensive video, CD Rom and DVD collection.

A home delivery service is available to patrons who are unable to make the journey to the library. For further information, please contact the Library.

Broome Public Library is part of a State-Wide service provided by the State Library of Western Australia. The service which includes the State Reference Library, the Battye Library and Music and Performing Arts Collection.

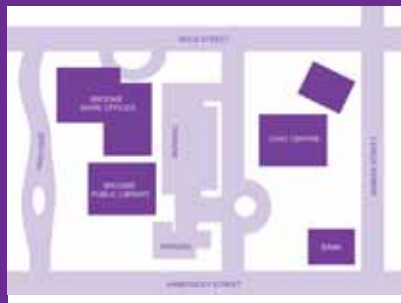
## Online Services

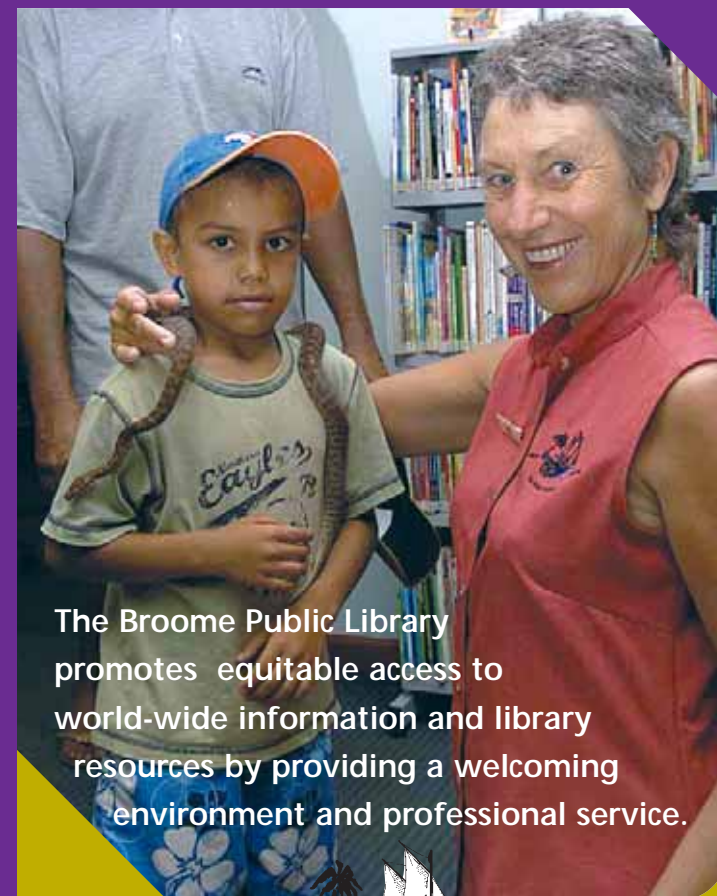

# LIBRARY SERVICES



The Broome Public Library promotes equitable access to world-wide information and library resources by providing a welcoming environment and professional service.



## The Library Collection

Broome Public Library is available to all members of the community and is well stocked with over 20,000 volumes.

The library also provides an inter-library loans service, remote mailing service, Internet access and computer terminals for library patrons.

Broome Public Library is part of the State-Wide library network, allowing patrons to access the resources of the State and beyond.

The Library contains a comprehensive collection of: Fiction and Non-fiction Books; Large Print Books; Magazines and Newspapers; Video and Audio Cassettes; CD Roms and DVD Collection.

## New Stock

There is a regular exchange of books to ensure up-to-date and varied stock. New books are displayed on our feature stands for one week. If you would like to borrow these books, ask the Library staff to reserve the books you require.

## Community Programs and Facilities



Children's Story Time for ages 3-5 is held every Tuesday from 10.30am except school holidays. Regular "Meet the Author Evenings" are held. Photocopying facilities are available.

## Membership

Library membership is free to all residents of Broome. To become a member you will need to show documentary proof of your name and current residential address and an alternative contact address. Suitable documents for residential address verification include:

- Current WA Drivers Licence
- Social Security Card
- Rates Notice
- Western Horizon Account
- Rental Receipt or Lease from a Real Estate Agent.

### Visitor Membership

Visitors and temporary residents can pay a refundable deposit of \$20 per individual or \$40 per family.

If you are a current WA Public Library member, you may use your library card at the Broome Public Library.



## Borrower Rights

Please bring your Library Card when borrowing or renewing items. You can borrow four items at a time. This can be a combination of Books, Magazines, CD-roms, Cassettes Videos or DVD's.

There is a maximum of two videos/DVD's per borrower at any one time. Items can be borrowed for two weeks. These can be renewed for a further two weeks, providing they have not been requested by another library patron.
