**Location:** Carnarvon Street, Chinatown

**Closest accessible parking:** One accessible bay close by outside BWS Liquor Store.

**Pick up / set down bay:** No.

**Closest public transport:** Town Bus stops either

- on Carnarvon Street, at the Male Oval, or
- on Dampier Terrace, near Shady Lane

**Closest accessible toilet:** Opposite, at the Paspaley Shopping Centre

**Signage:** Clear and easy to read from Roadway.

**External access:** A barrier free pedestrian ramp 3.9degrees (1.15) and 1700mm wide connects to the footpath to the entrance. Wheelchair access (Y++).

**Main entrance:** Level entry with automatic single glass door of 900mm widths with 1000mm clearance on the latch side. Wheelchair access (Y++).

**Internal:** Low pile carpeting throughout. There is sufficient circulation space for all types of wheelchairs.

**Writing tables:** Information brochures are at standing height. The information displayed has good colour contrast and is in an easy to read font.

**Teller counter:** Is at sitting height with Perspex windows.

**ATM:** Is located outside and has a card insertion height of 1400mm.

**Cueing system:** Counter service operates by the customer service staff calling 'next please'. There are no visual prompts.
