Entrance door: Wide double doors held open.

Internal: Wooden floor with average wheelchair circulation (Y).

Food counter: Table service throughout. Counter only used to pay or for take away orders.

Seating: Firm wooden movable chairs and corner leg tables. The table heights are 740mm and the wooden chairs with firm back support are 470mm high.

Menu: Easy to read table Menu with good colour contrast, 12 point font and in large print.

Accessible toilet: The nearest disabled toilet can be found at Paspaley Shopping Centre, approx. 7 minutes away.
