Location: Corner Hamersley/Frederick/Stewart and Weld Street, located on a whole block, in the gardens of the Broome Courts House.

Opening hours:

Saturday & Sunday: 8:00am – 1.00pm from May to October

Saturday only: 8:00am – 1.00pm from November to April

Closest accessible parking: There is one designated disabled parking bay located on Weld Street. Otherwise there is ample parking around the block.

Closest public transport: Town Bus stop at the Broome Motel on Frederick Street just opposite the Court House.

Closest pick up / set down bay: Not available, but it's possible to do so on Stewart street just in front of the market entrance.

Closest accessible toilet: The nearest disabled toilet is on Male Oval Carnarvon Street about 7-10 minutes away. The nearest accessible toilets are on the complex at Stewart Street side.

Signage: There is a banner attached to trees on Corner Hamersley & Frederick Street, next to the Courthouse sign.

External Access: 8 large and wide open access entries brick paved or tarred paths leading to the markets stalls.

Internal: The pathways within are mostly wide and of gravel surface. In most areas is plenty of circulation space available. There are many trees around to give some shade.

Seating: There is no seating around other than the lawn.
