## **Broome Laundromat**

**Location:** External Shop at Paspaley Plaza Shopping Centre with entrance from Short Street

**Facilities:** Self Service coin operated Laundromat

**Opening Hours:** Monday to Sunday 7.00am - 9.00pm with last wash at 8.00pm

**Telephone:** Paspaley Plaza Shopping Centre Management Phone: (08) 9193 5928

**Closest accessible parking:** 2 designated accessible parking bays at the Short Street car park.

**Pick up / set down bay:** No.

**Closest public transport:** Town Bus stop at Carnarvon Street, about 5-7 min away.

**Closest accessible toilet:** The nearest accessible toilet is in Paspaley Shopping Centre (see report).

**Signage:** Clear signage readable from Short Street car park.

**External access:** Barrier free pedestrian ramp with an 18.5 degree gradient.

**Main entrance:** Open double door 900mm wide on each side is always open with 900mm clearance on the latch side. (Wheelchair access Y++).

**Internal:** There is tiled flooring throughout with a central table, 1000mm wide and 940mm high. The aisles between the tables and washing machines/walls are 1400 wide. There are 5 top loading washing machines and 4 front loading dryer (2 in sitting height). The change machine is at sitting height and the soap machine in standing height. There are chairs with firm seats and a sitting height of 470mm available.
