Closest accessible parking: There are 2 designated disabled parking bays situated at the entrance fronting Broome Highway.

Pick up / set down bay: There is one bay near the entrance.

Closest public transport: The Town Bus Stop is just next to the Visitor Centre.

Closest accessible toilet: Onsite.

Signage: Signage has good colour contrast and easy to read as does most of the information leaflets.

External access: A wide boardwalk with handrails of 1800mm on a gentle slope of 2.7degree gradient leads to the entrance.

Main entrance: The entry door is a wide 1600mm automatic entry door. Wheelchair access (Y++).

Internal: The area is brightly lit with terrazzo flooring. There is good wheelchair access through the isles of brochures (Y++).

Displays: The Display stands 1400mm high.

Service counters: There is a long service counter 1000mm high with a table and seats at either end. The tables are 760mm and the chairs 480mm high.

Payment counter: The counter stands 1000mm high.

Cueing system: Counter service operates by the customer service staff calling 'next please'. There are no visual prompts.

Accessible toilet: The designated unisex toilet is situated in a corridor of the main area and it is clearly signed. The access is barrier free. There are also an emergency button and a change table.

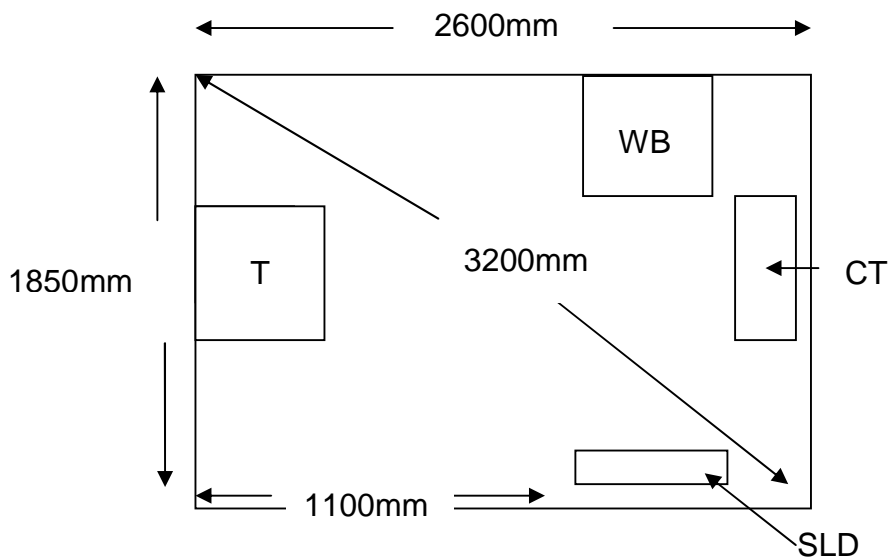
Toilet door: The door is 1000mm wide with a push button entry and with 1100mm clearance on the latch side.

Pan height: 460mm

Wash Basin: 800mm

Change Table: 880mm

Lighting: Automatic lighting
