Facilities: It is a pavilion area open to the public for meditation, yoga, tai chi and introduction to Buddhism.

Closest accessible parking: There is one accessible parking bay in the car park right in front.

Pick up / set down bay: No.

Closest public transport: Town Bus Stop on Sanctuary Drive about 5-7minutes away.

Closest accessible toilet: The nearest toilet is Cable Beach Public Toilet, about 15 minutes away.

Signage: Large bold lettering can be read from the road

External access: A barrier free pathway leads to the entrance.

Main entrance: Open double door entry 1450mm wide.

Internal area: Wooden floor with ample circulation space for all styles of wheelchairs. Information brochures are at sitting height and seating is provided. The chairs are firm with backrests and armrests

Outside area: A ramped boardwalk with a gradient 2.9 (1.19) and 1200mm wide with handrails at either side (1000mm high) leads to the Buddha and outside prayer and meditation area.
