**Closest accessible parking:** No accessible bays in the both car parks (one is right at the front and one is directly on the corner.)

**Pick up / set down bay:** Possible in the car park cnr Barker & Hamersley Street.

**Closest public transport:** Town Bus Stop either on

- Cnr Hamersley Street & Carnarvon Street, at Matso's Brewery, about 10 minutes away, or
- Frederick Street, at Broome Motel about 10-12 minutes away

**Closest accessible toilet:** The nearest accessible toilet is at the Broome Public Library about 2 minutes away.

**Signage:** Clear & easy to read from roadway.

**External access:** Level & barrier free from the car park (Y++).

**Main entrance:** Level entry automatic double doors 1050mm wide wheelchair access (Y++).

**Internal:** Tiles and low pile carpeting. There is sufficient circulation space for all types of wheelchairs. Writing table is at sitting height. Chairs have a seat height of 450mm.

**Displays:** Information displays are accessible at sitting height.

**Teller counters:** They are at standing height with Perspex windows.

**Cueing system:** Counter service operates by the customer service staff calling 'next please'.
