Closest accessible parking: One accessible parking bay on cable beach car park very close to the entrance.

Pick up / set down bay: No

Closest public transport: Town Bus Stop close to the restaurant.

Accessible toilet: onsite.

Signage: Good coloured contrast readable from a distance.

External access: A wide barrier free pedestrian ramp with a gradient 4.3 (1.13) leads to the entrance.

Entrance door: 870mm wide door open during business hours.

Internal: There is sufficient space for all styles of wheelchairs to move between the tables. Wheelchair access (Y++).

Food counter: The cake display is at sitting height.

Payment Counter: It is at standing height.

Seating: The chairs have backrests with a seat height of 440mm. Tables are central pedestal with good knee clearance.

Menu: These are in good colour contrast and easy to read with a 12 point font.

Accessible toilet: There is a unisex accessible toilet available.

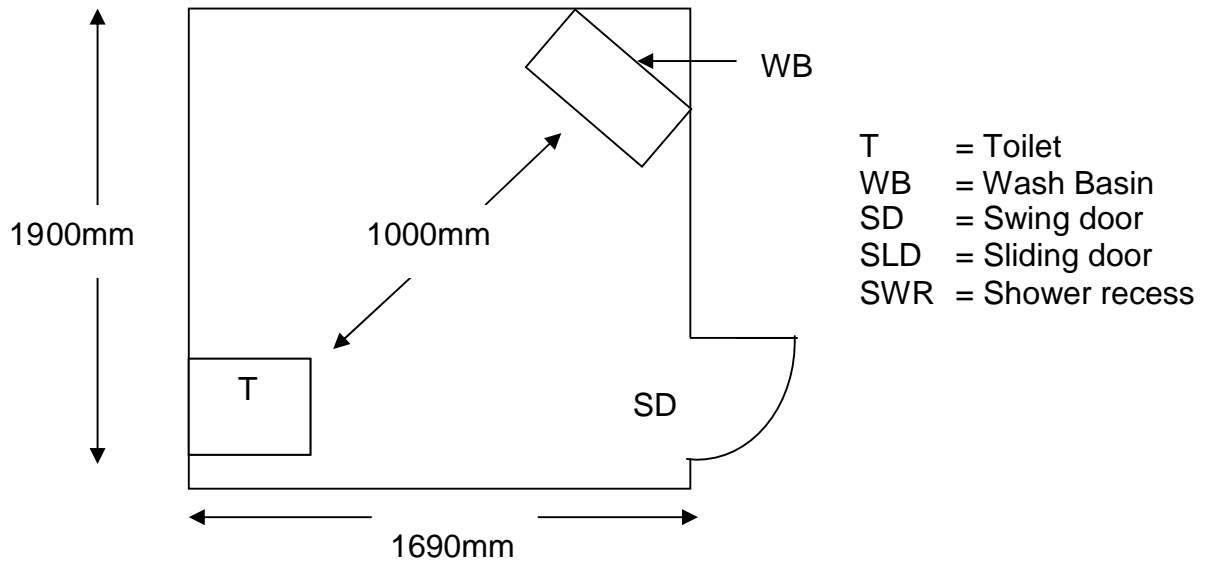
External access: Suitable for all wheelchairs.

The toilet has a 870mm wide swing door has a D handle and a small snib. The door is light to open and easy to close.

Pan height: 460mm

Basin height: 800mm with knee access.

Lighting: The light is on at all times.
