Question – John Bucknall: *“My question relates to to concerns over the Council's commitment to, and management of, the first of the six principles outlined in the ' Future Land Use Framework and Planning Strategies for the Broome Townsite' report of the Broome Planning Steering Committee.*

Namely, 'the requirement that, growth in resident and visitor population should be managed to support and retain the character and identity of the place. The community's varied values, beliefs and background, and the diverse ways they live, recreate and undertake their lives should be respected and accommodated'.
