SUMMARY: Minyirr Park would like the Shire to provide comment and input on the Draft Strategic Plan developed by Traditional Custodians and Minyirr Park staff in 2006.

BACKGROUND

Minyirr Park Traditional Custodians and staff, including on site supervisors and the ground work team, met in December 2006/7 to develop a strategic plan. Sharon Griffiths facilitated the Strategic Planning Workshop and is the author of the Draft Plan.

The Draft Strategic Plan has been given interim approval by Rubibi in May 2007.

COMMENT

The Minyirr Park Strategic Plan 2007 – 2011 provides a vision and direction for Minyirr Park. This document will be used to set the directions of business plans and discussions regarding the future management of Minyirr Park and Coastal Reserves.

CONSULTATION

The Draft Strategic Plan has been given interim approval by Rubibi subject to the outcomes of Native Title negotiations. The next step is consultation and input from Minyirr Park's partner, the Shire.
