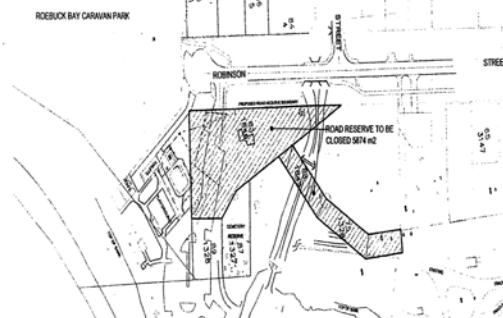


# Shire of Broome

## PROPOSED PERMANENT ROAD CLOSURE

1. In accordance with Section 58 of the Land Administration Act 1997, Council advises its intention to request the permanent closure of part of the existing Robinson Street road reserve adjacent Town Beach, and the section of road reserve adjacent Lot 2070, totalling 0.5874 Ha in area.

2. The purpose of the proposed closure is the creation of a Recreation, Drainage, Historical and Cultural Display Reserve.
