# VESTING ORDER

I, Air Chief Marshal Sir Wallace Kyle, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Honourable Order of the Bath, Knight Commander of the Royal Victorian Order, Commander of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Companion of the Distinguished Service Order, Distinguished Flying Cross, Knight of Grace of the Most Venerable Order of the Hospital of St. John of Jerusalem, Governor in and over the State of Western Australia and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, do hereby, in pursuance of the powers enabling me in that behalf, and under and by virtue of the provisions of section 33 of the Land Act, 1933, direct that Reserve No. 8656

shall vest in and be held by the Shire of Broome

in trust for the following objects and purposes (that is to say) "Office Accommodation"

or other the purposes for which the land is reserved, with power to the said Shire of Broome

subject to the approval in writing of the Minister for Lands to each and every lease or assignment of lease being first obtained, to lease the whole or any portion thereof for any term not exceeding 21 years from the date of the lease, subject nevertheless to the powers reserved to me by section 37 of the said Act; provided that no such lease or assignment of lease shall be valid or operative until the approval of the Minister for Lands, or an officer authorised in that behalf by the Minister, has been endorsed on the Lease Instrument, or Deed of Assignment, as the case may be.

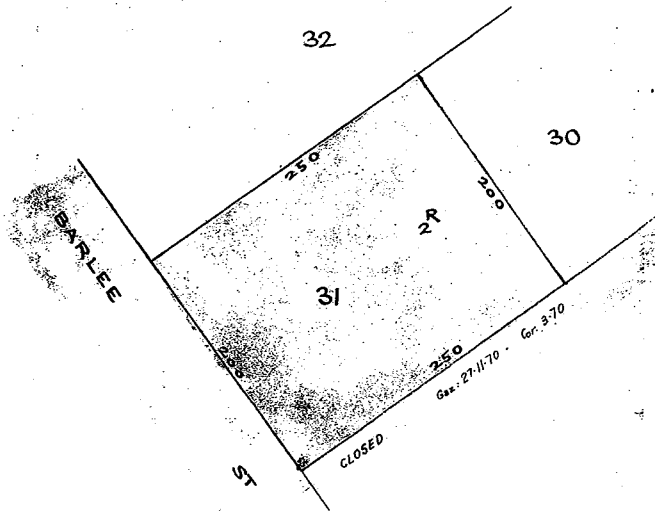
