PREAMBLE

Under the provisions of Section 3.50 of the Local Government Act 1995, Council closes the Broome Cape Leveque Road to all vehicles of a gross vehicle mass over eleven (11) tonnes each wet season. Exceptions for over-limit vehicles may be granted to vehicles supplying "essential" services under specific permits issued by the Chief Executive Officer.

- Road Train trip requests to be considered on their merits and be subject to appropriate conditions
- If the road is closed, no access is permitted
- This permit is subject to daily assessment of road conditions
- If substantial rain has occurred or is occurring, drive with extreme caution
- No responsibility will be taken by the Shire to recover bogged or disabled vehicles and any damages caused by any 'permit' vehicles may be chargeable to the permit holders, depending on circumstances at the time
- Travel is at drivers own risk and the applicant shall indemnify and keep indemnified the Shire of Broome and all their respective agents, officers, members and employees from and against all claims, demands, suits, proceedings, actions, causes of action, liabilities, losses and damage sustained, suffered or incurred by the applicant whilst travelling on Cape Leveque Road
- The permit can be cancelled at any time at the discretion of the Chief Executive Officer, if circumstances warrant
- This permit must be carried in the approved vehicle at all times and presented on demand
- This permit is for a single / multiple trip.(cross out as applicable)
- If substantial rain has occurred, the applicant **must** contact and discuss with the Shire of Broome if travelling on Cape Leveque Road is permitted

ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS:

The applicant agrees to all of the above conditions of this permit and will return a copy of their Main Roads permit for this vehicle with this application or the above request will not be considered.
