Australian Government funding for HYPE project

Federal Member for Kalgoorlie, Barry Haase, today announced that the Shire of Broome will receive a grant under the Australian Government's *National Crime Prevention Programme* to address anti-social behaviour.

The Shire will receive \$197,150 for the Helping Young People Engage (HYPE) Project to continue for two and a half years.

The project aims to enhance community safety by building positive relationships between young people, service providers, local council, the police and community members, and by fostering young people's inclusion and constructive participation in public spaces.

"The State Labor Government has failed to adequately fund crime prevention and law enforcement, even though they are State responsibilities, leaving our community at risk from anti-social behaviour," said Mr Haase. "That is why I have been working with the community to secure funding for practical local projects, so we can help to crack down on crime locally."
