Broome Recreation & Aquatic Centre Tennis Courts to be Rejuvenated

Tennis courts at the Broome Recreation and Aquatic Centre will be undergoing maintenance to provide an improved playing surface for players.

With eight synthetic courts to rejuvenate, the work will begin on March 17 and is expected to take approximately four days to complete at a cost of \$15,000.

For safety reasons, the courts will be unavailable for all users use during the maintenance period.

The process involves a contractor repairing the playing surface which also involves removing excess sand and other materials which have accumulated through usage of the courts over the years.

“This overhaul of the courts will encourage increased use of the tennis courts by the community and visitors to Broome,” said Director of Community Services, Chris Jackson.

“The end result will improve the surface of the courts and we apologise for any inconvenience caused,” he said.

Broome Recreation and Aquatic Centre manager Michelle Barton has liaised with the Broome Tennis Club president regarding the temporary closure of the courts
