

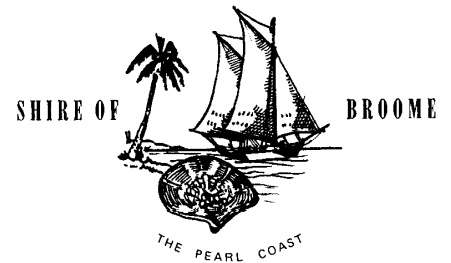

Shire of Broome Community Survey 2007

The Shire of Broome is undertaking a community survey to better understand community views and values about Broome, and also to find out how residents of Broome feel about some of the services that the Shire provides. This will inform the development of a Community Development Strategy for the Shire of Broome.

A random representative sample of Broome residents will be contacted in the early evening by phone, during the weeks April 23 – 27 and April 30 – May 4.

Surveys will take approximately 15 minutes to complete and all answers will be confidential.

These surveys will form part of a bigger consultation process that will also involve focus groups organised around the needs of specific target groups in Broome such as children, youth, older people, people with disabilities, men, women and tourists/visitors.

The Shire will use feedback from these surveys and focus groups in their Community Development Strategy. They will also be used to assist the Shire with their daily operations.
