Keep Your Peepers Peeled for Puppies

Shire of Broome Rangers are urging the community to report any incidents of puppies being dumped around town together with any information that could help the Police prosecute those responsible.

Ranger Mark Golding said he was recently called to Broome Veterinary Hospital where a puppy had been handed in after being found on Cable Beach Road West.

"I was told by a couple driving to Cable Beach saw a car stop on the side of the road and throw something out. Upon closer inspection they discovered it was a puppy," said Mark.

"They rescued the puppy and took her to the vet."

"We urge the couple that saved the puppy to contact us so we can obtain more information to follow up the incident," he said.

"We ask that everyone keep an eye out for puppies being dumped and provide rangers or Police with as much information as possible so an investigation can be undertaken and further action taken against those responsible," said Mark.

The puppy is currently living with Mark and will be released to SAFE once rangers have exhausted all means of ways to gather information on this case.
