

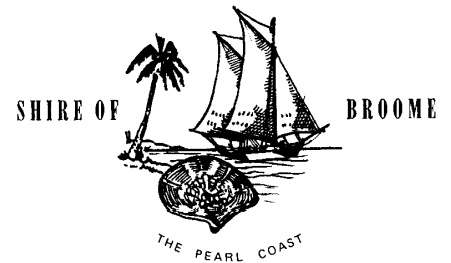

## **Beach Services Return for 2007 Season**

Shire of Broome's Beach Services return to Cable Beach for the 2007 season.

Beach Inspector Tim Trew will once again patrol the recommended swimming area at Cable Beach, adjacent to the Broome Surf Lifesaving Club.

"We will be providing a rescue service, first aid and beach safety information to beach goers," he said.

"The red and yellow flags will designate the recommended swimming area."

"Don't forget that stingers can be present in the water, even during the dry season and pay attention to any warning signs," said Mr Trew.

As well as being Broome's Beach Inspector, Tim has added further to his surf lifesaving achievements.

Tim recently returned from the National Surf Lifesaving Championships at Scarborough Beach where he took out the silver medal in the Champion Patrol Competition.

"Tim's experience as a surf lifesaver together with this being his third season patrolling Cable Beach means the beach is in good hands," said Paul Dickson, Manager of Emergency, Ranger and Beach Services.

Beach Services will operate every day from 9am to 4.30pm until October.
