Cable Beach closed to all vehicles until further notice

The vehicle access at Cable Beach will be closed to all vehicles until further notice due to the significant sand erosion caused by TC Carlos, which has led to erosion and instability of some dunes, loss of sand from the beach and large amounts of exposed rock.

The Shire has started work to restore some of the dunes and stabilise banks and will continue to do so next week. This work has been done under monitoring of traditional land owners, Yawuru. Once the Shire is confident that the area is safe for the public, it will re-open vehicle access.

It is expected that the beach sand will gradually return to the beach over the next few months as part of the annual cycle when milder weather returns.

The Shire will advise the public once vehicle access is re-opened.
