Beach closed overnight as croc monitoring continues

An update on the crocodile sighted today at Cable Beach:

Cable Beach will be closed to all users (vehicles and bathers) overnight. Lifeguards and Department of Environment and Conservation staff will continue to monitor the area today, as light permits.

The situation will be reviewed at first light tomorrow morning. The Shire will advise the public when the beach is re-opened.

The crocodile, which is estimated to be 2m long, was sighted approximately 70m off the shore, directly in front of the surf club.
