

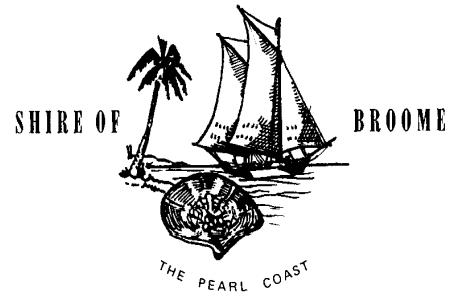

Allen Grosse Resigns from Broome Council

Allen Grosse has formally resigned as a Broome Shire Councillor effective from 5 January 2006.

The decision to resign came about because Mr Grosse will be relocating with his family to the eastern states.

Shire President Graeme Campbell said that Mr Grosse had been a hardworking member of the Council since 2003.

“While Allen was always quick with a quip during Council meetings, he always took his role as councillor very seriously,” said Cr Campbell.

“Being a councillor takes a large chunk of your personal time and Allen rose to the challenge, putting in as many hours as needed to benefit the community.

“Over the past three decades Allen’s contribution to the Broome community and the Kimberley has meant so much to so many people.

“As a councillor, his strong commitment to policy development was appreciated and helped move us forward.

“His resignation wasn’t a complete surprise, as we have known for some time that he was considering relocating.

“He will be sorely missed. We wish him, and his family all the very best for the future,” said the Shire President.

With Council elections due in October, a decision has not yet been made as to whether an extraordinary election will be held to replace Mr Grosse in the meantime.
