The Shire of Broome has approximately 250 food businesses located within its jurisdiction, which include restaurants, cafes, snack bars, markets, bakeries, childcare centres and hospitals. Shire's Environmental Health Officers conduct routine inspections of these businesses to ensure that food they serve is safe. They also provide advice on food safety to business owners; investigate complaints about food handling and food poisoning.

Routine food inspections conducted by Environmental Health Officers involve an assessment of areas including:

- Receipt of food
- Storage of food
- Processing of food
- Display of food
- Packaging of food
- Transportation and distribution of food
- Recalls/food disposal
- Health, hygiene and knowledge of food handlers
- Condition and hygiene of food premises
