NOTES:

Infringements may be withdrawn in the following circumstances (supporting documentation MUST be provided):

- 1. You were not the driver at the time of the infringement issue and you have supplied the driver's name and address details.
- 2. Vehicle broken down, flat tyre, etc (RAC callout documentation or other evidence of mechanical failure is to be provided.)
- 3. Disabled parking permit displayed that may have fallen from the dashboard. (ACROD permit produced)
- 4. Immediate medical attention being undertaken /required by the driver. (Medical certification /document to be provided.
- 5. At the time of the infringement there was a special circumstance related to mental health issues that contributed to the offence.
- 6. At the time of the infringement there were exceptional circumstances. (running late, appointment over time, could not find a park, did not understand the signage, did not see the sign etc is not exceptional circumstances)
- 7. Failure to pay or appeal your infringement within 28 days of the issue may result in additional penalty costs.
- 8. Infringements may be withdrawn and referred to the Magistrates Court for hearing.
