Objective:

To provide guidelines for the payment of a reward to any person or persons giving information leading to the conviction of persons who have vandalised or stolen Shire of Broome property.

Definitions:

Nil.

Policy:

Shire policy is to pay a reward to any person or persons giving information which leads to the successful conviction of persons who have wilfully damaged or stolen Shire property. The amount of the reward to be reviewed annually by Council. Shire staff, Councillors and members of the WA Police Service are not eligible for this reward.

Guidelines

The reward policy is to be regularly advertised in newsletters and other information bulletins.

All information is to be passed on to the Chief Executive Officer who will investigate the matter and make any enquiries necessary to verify the validity of the information and contact the Police.

All staff will treat the informants name and all personal details in the strictest confidence and will not divulge their name to any other party.

The Chief Executive Officer will arrange for the payment in cash to the informant once the information as received has been acted on by the Police and/ or a conviction is recorded.
