Funds boost for Broome community groups

Twelve community projects will share more than \$56,000 in funding support following the latest round of the Shire of Broome Community Sponsorship Program and Energy Developments Pty Ltd West Kimberley Community Donations.

Applications for a second round of funding for 2018 will now open in August to help community-based organisations to develop social, cultural, economic, recreational, environmental and reconciliation projects and initiatives that benefit the Broome community.
