Rangers prepare to crack down on illegal campers

Shire of Broome Rangers are preparing to crack down on illegal camping around the town as the busy tourist season gets underway, including again using wheel clamps when necessary.

Shire Ranger Co-ordinator, Mark O'Connor, says the Shire requires that all camping in the Broome townsite be in caravan parks, and not in public carparks, road verges or elsewhere.

"Tourism is an important part of Broome and the Shire welcomes visitors of all kinds, but unfortunately a minority do the wrong thing and detract from the ability of everyone else to enjoy our town," Mr O'Connor says.

"The first resort of Rangers when they find someone illegally camped is to issue a warning. If warnings are ignored they will be issued a \$100 infringement if the vehicle is registered in WA.

"In most cases this has the desired effect of moving the offenders on, but wheel clamps will be used as a further enforcement option when these other steps fail to get a result."

Broome set to commemorate Anzac Centenary

Broome will mark Anzac Centenary commemorations with an expanded Anzac Day Dawn Service, an Anzac Day eve commemoration, a new memorial wall and upgrades to the existing war memorial.

The traditional Dawn Service and parade at Bedford Park starts at 5.45am sharp on Saturday 25 April, and this year will include a moving tribute involving more than 40 St Mary's College students, a representative of the WA Police Pipe Band, and more.


In addition, an Anzac Day eve commemoration will be held at 5.30pm on Friday 24 April at Town Beach, again featuring a performance by the WA Police Pipe Band representative.

The war memorial in Bedford Park will be upgraded and improved with funding from the Shire of Broome and the Federal Government's Anzac Centenary Local Grants Program.

Broome Shire President, Graeme Campbell, said work would include installing two new memorial walls flanking the cenotaph, rendering and painting brickwork on the new walls and the existing cenotaph, and replacing pavement with exposed aggregate concrete.
