

Cyclone Season is almost upon us and the Shire of Broome will again

conduct its FREE annual ‘Pre-Cyclone Clean Up’

You can assist in making this free service successful by observing the following guidelines:

YES ITEMS

Pile 1 - Metals



White goods, Fridges with doors removed and degased



Scrap iron, other waste metals and old empty tins

Pile 2 - Non Metals



Furniture and mattresses



E-waste



Household electrical items

NO ITEMS



NO tyres, batteries or car parts



NO household waste



NO gas bottles



NO asbestos, oil, paint, liquid waste, chemical or hazardous waste



NO green waste

• NO commercial building materials

• NO flares

• NO fire extinguishers

This clean up is offered to residential properties within the Broome townsite and removes debris which could pose a hazard in the event of a Cyclone.

Items placed on the verge not meeting the above detailed criteria may not be removed and may be viewed as illegal dumping and infringements can be issued by Shire of Broome Rangers.

Please be aware that clean-up crews will be working on local roads during this time. The Shire of Broome asks that drivers please be patient and slow down when approaching work areas.

Please ensure that you have all items on the verge in two piles as detailed in the guidelines above. These items should be placed in a neat and tidy manner prior to the nominated collection date. Items placed on the street verge after the nominated collection period will not be collected and removal shall be the responsibility of the property owner or occupant.

Please place items on your verge between the 21st and 30th of October 2016

Area	Collection
Old Broome	31st Oct - 2nd Nov
Roebuck Estate	3rd November
Sunset Rise	4th November
Cable Beach	7th - 9th November
Broome North	10th November
