## Funding help for community groups

Community groups and events that would benefit from funding help are being encouraged to apply for the latest round of community sponsorship grants.

Groups and events can apply for up to \$10,000 each under the Shire of Broome Community Sponsorship and Energy Developments Limited West Kimberley Community Donations programs.

Applications are open and will be accepted until 28 February 2017, with an information session to be held on 24 January 2017.

Broome Shire President, Ron Johnston, says that in 2016 more than \$105,000 was distributed to 19 different groups and events.

"Broome is blessed with a vibrant and active community and an exciting calendar of events, and the annual Community Sponsorship program is one of the ways the Shire supports these groups - by providing funds to help them achieve their goals," Cr Johnston says.
