Shire of Broome Christmas operating hours

Shire of Broome Administration Office, Broome Civic Centre Office, Depot and remaining operations not listed separately below will be closed:

Monday 24 December 2018 to Tuesday 1 January 2019 (inclusive). Some staff will be rostered on to handle routine duties and emergencies. The Civic Centre will be available for hire during the Christmas closure period excluding Christmas Day and Boxing Day, however all booking arrangements must be made prior to the closure of the Civic Centre Office.

Broome Public Library will be closed:

Saturday 22 December 2018 to Tuesday 1 January 2019 (inclusive).

Broome Recreation and Aquatic Centre will be closed:

Annual Meeting of Electors this Thursday

The Annual Meeting of Electors for the Shire of Broome will be held this Thursday, 13 December, at 4pm in the Council Chambers at the Shire Administration.

The meeting includes a report from the Shire President, receipt of the 2017/18 Annual Report, and general business including questions from electors.

or printed copies are available on request from the administration.

Electors with queries about the Annual Financial Report are invited to seek clarification prior to the meeting during normal office hours.

Support for economic, events, tourism initiatives

Applications are open for funding to help local organisations develop economic, events and tourism projects and initiatives that benefit the community.

The Shire expanded its annual Community Sponsorship Program at the beginning of 2018 to include the new Economic, Events and Tourism Development funding stream, with 11 Broome organisations sharing more than \$200,000 in funding in the inaugural round.

Applications for the new funding round opened on 1 November and close at 4pm on 11 January 2019.

Applicants can request up to \$70,000 in cash support, and \$30,000 of in-kind support, up to 50 per cent of the total project cost. For full details head to the Shire website.
