Town Beach is an important location for Broome people and visitors, significant for its important role in recreation, culture and heritage.

Town Beach is the home of the Staircase to the Moon Markets drawing thousands of visitors each year. The water playground is a favourite for local and visiting families. The Pioneer Cemetery, Old Jetty site, Catalina's Flying Boat wrecks, Broome Museum and Indigenous culture all form part of the important site.

The Town Beach Project builds on these strengths and values with a range of sub-projects that will improve the precinct.
