Celebrating Library Week in Broome

Library and Information Week gets underway this Monday, 20 May, and Broome Public Library is celebrating with several fun events.

Library and Information Week runs from 20–26 May and will include National Simultaneous Storytime and the launch of Broome Beach Books for 2019.

Shire of Broome Library Coordinator, Sally Eaton, said National Simultaneous Storytime was happening on Wednesday 22 May, with Broome children joining others around Australia to read the same story at the same time.
