Take the challenge in Broome's annual fun run

Broome's only annual fun run is happening again in June and entries are now open.

The Shire of Broome is partnering with the Indigenous Marathon Foundation and the Department of Sport and Recreation to present the Deadly BRAC 2 Beach Fun Run on Sunday 12 June from 10am, with a choice of 4km or 8km distances to suit all fitness levels.

BRAC Manager, Casey Zepnick, said there were prizes for the fastest male and female, junior male and female, and for the sporting group, community group or workplace with the most entrants.

"In its sixth year the Deadly BRAC 2 Beach Fun Run not only gives accomplished runners an opportunity to compete, but the 2016 event is focusing on attracting beginners to take part," Mr Zepnick said.

Changes this year include reduced distances and a later start time to encourage greater participation, along with a simplified running route and a new finish line overlooking Cable Beach in front of the Broome Surf Lifesaving Club.

The Surf Club Nippers will host a sausage sizzle at the finish, so competitors and supporters are encouraged to bring a gold coin to grab a snag at the end of the run.

"Both fun run courses start at BRAC and finish overlooking Cable Beach, and as always buses will be provided to ferry participants back to BRAC after the presentations."

Entry is \$30 for adults, \$15 for juniors/concession and \$50 for a family of two adults and two children.
