What's happening at Cable Beach?

Work has commenced on coastal remediation works between the Surf Club and Cable Beach House restaurant and the demolition and reconstruction of the beach access stairs at both locations.

The stairs near the restaurant are now closed, but you can access the beach 90m to the north. Please note that there are still exposed rocks at the bottom of the stairs.

The foreshore path between the restaurant and the Surf Club will be temporarily closed. The Surf Club can be accessed from the adjacent car park.

Over behind the Surf Club, Shire crews are installing a new footpath near the Sanctuary Road roundabout to link the car parks. Work is also about to start on garden beds, featuring native plants cultivated at the Shire depot from local seeds.
