Broome's not-for-profit organisations, sporting groups and community organisations are invited to apply for a grant of up to \$5,000 from the Shire.

The Shire of Broome provided a helping hand to local community groups earlier this year by providing over \$50,000 in funding to a range of worthy recipients as part of the COVID-19 Community Support Package.

This latest round of funding is open, with local groups able to apply for small grants, which are considered by the Shire's Community Sponsorship Assessment Working Group.
