Registrations open for BRAC 2 Beach Fun Run

Broome's only fun run event is returning for 2021, with athletes getting ready to lace up their running shoes on Sunday, June 27.

Participants can opt to take on the 4km or 8km courses and the event can be completed as a walk, run or wheelchair event.
