

DEMOLITION

DEMOLITION

A **demolition permit** is required for ALL Class 1 dwellings, and Class 2-9 buildings to dismantle and remove the building.

ALL Commercial (Class 2-9) buildings require a *registered demolition contractor* to be the permit holder.

Any building containing **asbestos** must remove the asbestos in an approved manner; refer to *Worksafe* link below

Any building containing more than 10m2 of asbestos will need a *register demolition* contractor to do the work

Small Class 10 buildings (sheds, garages etc.) <40m2 are exempt from a demolition permit.

Planning

Any proposed demolition work on Heritage significance sites are subject to *Planning Regs.*-please contact our Planning Dept before doing any work.

Demolition Permit

Our preferred format is PDF.

The following information is required:

BA5 Application form, completed and signed in all parts.

A minimum of one (1) photograph of the external elevation of the building.

Site plan drawn to a min scale of 1:200 showing the location of the building to be demolished, in relation to the property boundaries and other buildings on the property.

Schedule of Works

Please used the [Schedule of Works] as part of your application.

This includes a septic system decommissioning declaration form if applicable.

Fees - refer to the Application part of our website, we will contact you for fees payment.

Incomplete applications cause delays.
